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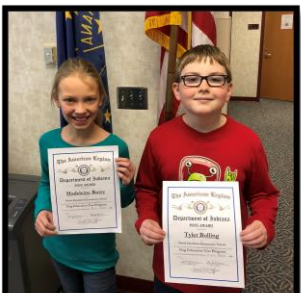

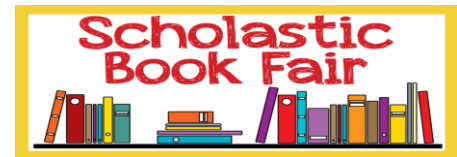

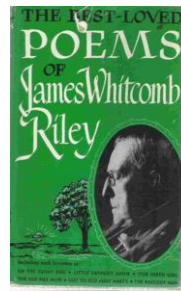

ECONOMICS for Kids

Our 3rd Grade Students will be taking part in a Purdue University Extension Program titled "Captain Cash". This program will teach basic financial management. This is an interactive program that will take place over a series of visits. Students will learn

- *How to identify different ways people save their income and explain advantages/disadvantages.
- *Explain how people save, develop a savings plan, and create a budget in order to make a purchase.
- *Teach the purpose and components of a personal budget and the impact it has on them.
- *Students will use skills such as problem-solving, planning, organizing, decision making & communication.



Our 4th Grade Students will be treated to a presentation of the life of James Whitcomb Riley. James Whitcomb Riley was an American writer, poet, and best-selling author. During his lifetime he was known as the "Hoosier Poet" and "Children's Poet" for his dialect works and his children's poetry. His poems

were intended to be humorous or sentimental, and of the approximately one thousand poems that Riley authored, the majority are in dialect. His famous works include "Little Orphan Annie" and "The Raggedy Man".
